Stan was instrumental in the founding of the Association, and even though he no longer held an office, he was influential in determining almost everything that we did last year. For instance, we published the newsletter, assisted

in contacting classmates for reunions, helped financially support the Grandview Singers, After Prom (a safe activity), Baccalaureate and the Highlander, which is always in danger of ceasing publication because of costs. We claimed our space on the Internet at www.grandviewheightsalumni.com. GHSA Annual Meeting

September 30, 7pm

Grandview Heights Public Library meeting room. All members and interested parties welcome to attend. GHSA members are asked to approve amendments to the Association regulations and by-laws and to elect Trustees. The Trustees, in turn, will elect officers. Other matters of interest will be discussed as the annual meeting will also serve as a board meeting. Proposed amendments:

1. Amend Section 1.01 to provide that failure to pay dues shall terminate a person's membership.
2. Amend Section 2.04 to provide that notices of meetings shall be given not less than seven nor more than 60 days prior to the meeting.
3. Amend Section 3.02 to provide that the number of Trustees shall be not less than three or more than 20.
4. Add Section 3.02.01 to provide that except for those persons who are Trustees immediately prior to the annual meeting held in the year 2009, no person shall serve as Trustee for more than five consecutive years.
5. Add Section 3.02.02 to provide that the Board may elect honorary members of the Board of Trustees. They shall have no vote as a Trustee.
6. Amend Section 4.01 to provide that officers of the Association must be members of the Board of Trustees.
7. Amend Section 4.02 to provide that officers shall hold office until the next annual meeting unless removed by majority vote of the Trustees and also to provide that no person shall hold the same office for more than four consecutive terms.

Raising bikes are a family thing with the Kochs. Big brother Terry '75, the bike idea originator, coordinates a huge bike-a-thon at his Cleveland employer, donating the bikes to Toys for Tots. As the holidays approach, Koch Gatch hopes that Alumni will remember the thrill of cruising down First Avenue towards Pierce Field or the pool, maybe riding no-handed, and that some will make a dream come true for an underprivileged kid in the area.
